Please note the following important information related to student finances:

- The price of tuition, room and board goes up an average of 4%-5% each year.
- All students who are first year and under age 21 are required to live on campus for their first year. Please note that the university does not assist students in finding off campus housing. Students will need to be responsible for their own apartment contract for any off campus housing.
- Fees and the cost of books vary according to the program/major.
- Vincennes University does not generally provide scholarships for international students. All students however are eligible to apply and compete for academic scholarships in their second year at VU.

Payment and Wire Transfer Information

Please note that payment for all tuition, fees, room and board is due at the beginning of school. First time international students register for classes once they arrive and complete placement testing. After class registration, the student will be able to get their school account balance from the Financial Service Department or online.

There are two options for paying your school bill:

1. Pay in full—due no later than the end of the second week of school.
2. Payment plan—this costs an extra \$30 for the semester. Full payment of the student account must be made by the mid-semester break (8 weeks).

These instructions should be used for sending wire payments directly to Vincennes University for credit to the student's account.
